Role Definition

Lighting Technician

I. Basic Function:

Assist with installing lighting instruments, focusing/adjusting, spot lights, special effects, carrying and storing equipment, etc.

You report to the Lighting Designer & Board Programmer.

II. Responsibilities:

1. Assist with hang lighting instruments and focusing instruments on specific areas of the stage and auditorium according to lighting plot
2. Patch wiring to dimmers and consoles, install security cables, make adjustments, run spot lights, and run special effects as needed and assigned
3. Run preprogrammed light board under the instruction of Light Board Programmer
4. Ensure backstage rope lighting is in place so areas are safe for performers and crew
5. Verify lighting instruments are working properly
6. Assure that the lighting instruments, cabling, and other effect & lighting equipment is safely installed and secured so the performers, crew, and audience is safe
7. Maintain a neat and tidy work area and the backstage light storage areas
8. Power down equipment at the conclusion of each performance or event
9. Notify Lighting Designer & Board Programmer, Stage Manager, and Auditorium Manager of damaged or troublesome equipment
10. Ensure that at the conclusion of a performance run or auditorium event that lighting equipment, including cabling and crossover lights, is returned to the designated storage area
